Effective March 23, 2018

- Felonies (non Capital cases), Civil Forfeiture, Non-capital Post Conviction - 2241, 2254, 2255

\$10,900 trial court level
\$7,800 appeal level
- Misdemeanors

\$3,100 trial court level
\$7,800 appeal level
- Pre-Trial Diversion

\$10,900 felony
\$3,100 misdemeanor
- Prisoner Transfers

\$3,100
- Paroled Prisoner Transfers

\$2,300 before Parole Commission
- Other: Probation Violation; Supervised Release Violation; Parole Violation; Material Witness (in custody); Mental Condition Hearings (with exceptions); Contempt (will possible loss of liberty); Witnesses (Grand Jury, court, Congress, etc); International Extradition

\$2,300 trial court level
- Services Other Than Counsel (Investigative, Expert, Etc.)

\$800 limit on services provided without prior authorization (once the \$800 limit has been met by any one or combination of service providers advanced authorization should be sought) EXCEPTION (by local General Order 01-17) paralegal and investigative work - those **each** have \$800 preauthorized that falls outside the aggregate \$800 limit.

\$2,500 total amount allowed per service provider per defendant without Circuit approval
