APPRENTICES START OUT AT \$26.34 PER HOUR

- **This Pre-Apprenticeship training course prepares students for entry into the Pacific Northwest Ironworkers and Employers Local #86 Apprenticeship program**
- **Students will obtain basic knowledge of ironwork which includes: terms, safety, measuring, tools, rigging, crane signaling, cutting and welding**

- **Students will receive training for an OSHA 10 safety card which will enable student to work safely on the job and at home**
- **Students will learn basic First Aid / CPR as related to job site and home (First Aid cards will be issued to students)**
- **Obtain working knowledge of physical aspects of the Ironworking trade and what it takes to maintain a job**
- **Obtain an apprenticeship into the Ironworkers after successful course completion**
- **Students completing this pre-apprenticeship will have direct entry into our Washington State registered Ironworkers Apprenticeship program**

- **Read, write and speak the English language**
- **Complete an application**
- **Be able to pass a Minimum Qualification Day**
- **Be able to pass a drug screening**
- **Be able to pass a Career Physical Aptitude Test (CPAT)**
