Apprenticeship is a combination of on-the-job training (OJT) and related classroom instruction under the supervision of a journey-level craft person or trade professional, in which workers learn the practical and theoretical aspects of a highly skilled occupations.

Apprentices who complete their program, earn approximately \$300,000 more over the span of their career than non-apprenticeship participants.
