

## Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)

### A job training and employment placement support program:

#### Eligible candidates for the program are:

- individuals 55 years old and older;
- unemployed for at least six (6) months;
- have a total family income of less than 125 percent of the Federal poverty level;

#### and must also meet one or more of the following eligibility criteria:

- Have low employment prospects;
- Are unable to find employment through the WOIA workforce system;
- Homeless or at Risk of Homelessness;
- Veterans and qualified spouses;
- Have Limited English proficiency;
- Have low literacy skills;
- Have a Disability.

### SCSEP Program Overview

- Goodwill of the Olympics and Rainier Region provide SCSEP services along with DSHS/ALISA Washington State Grantee, AARP, the National Asian Pacific Council on Aging and the National Indian Council on Aging.
- Individuals are assigned job training placements at Host Agencies in the community (usually a community non profit service organization) based on their preference and employment goals from their IEP (Individual Employment Plan).
- Additional requirements of the program are that the individual is an active participant in training and ongoing job-search activities which will lead to competitive employment in the community.
