

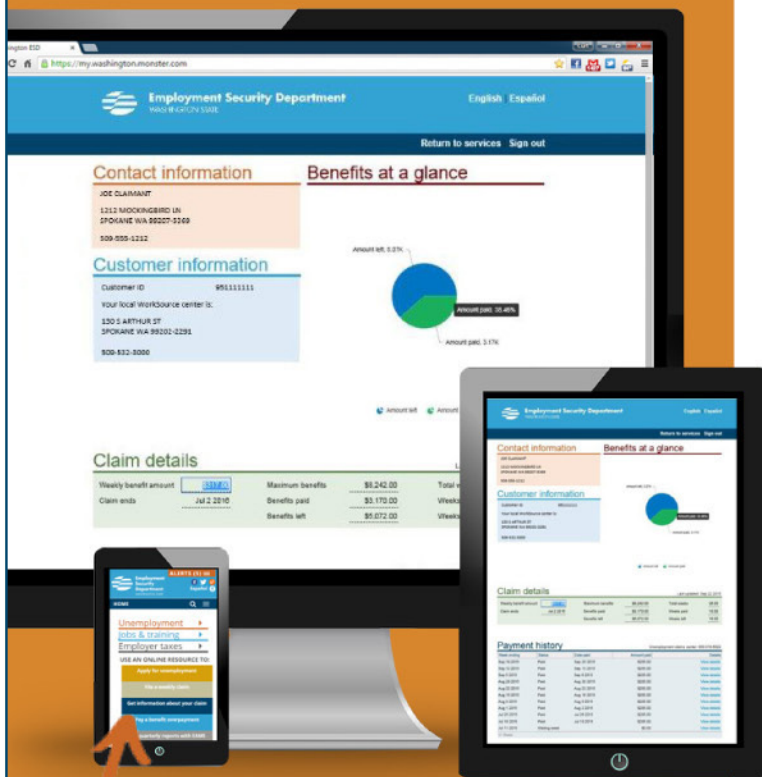
View your Washington state unemployment claim on your computer or mobile device.

Visit our website at secure.esd.wa.gov or from the “Get claim or wage information” link at esd.wa.gov.

The first time you visit the site, you will go through a multi-step registration process, including signing up for a Secure Access Washington (SAW) account if you don't already have one. You will need to provide an email address and answer questions to verify your identity.

Once logged on, you will see:

- Details about your benefits including the weekly benefit amount, maximum benefits you will receive, how many dollars and weeks you've been paid so far and how many remain.
- Payment history including the date you were paid, any deductions and the payment method.
- Your quarterly wages and hours as reported by Washington employers.
- The address of your local WorkSource center.
